### Book Week

Year R have been enjoying nursery rhymes this week, as they showed during their class assembly on Thursday. Changing a rhyme and making a moving picture were a couple of their activities. Year R had a lovely story time at Reigate library.

Year 1 used fruit as their theme for the week - through art by using different media for whole and cut fruit; science by using the five senses, including a great session of tasting fruit - some for the first time; design and technology by identifying different fruits. Literacy activities started by describing different fruits using adjectives, enjoying listening to fruit poems and then writing their own poems, using different poetry formats. Year 1 also explored the school library.

Year 2 visited Reigate library to investigate all the facilities that a local library offer. Using the rhyming story 'The Jolly Postman' children wrote a letter to The Jolly Postman inviting him to tea, thought of a suitable address and even wrote a reply from the postman himself. Children have also been learning and performing poems to each other in class.

All classes spent a session at the book fair enjoying new books.

On Friday poet Roger Stevens shared poems with each class - more details next week.
